Provides students an inclusive post-secondary education program.

Students who successfully complete the Seahawk NEST program will earn a Broward College Professional Certificate. Eligible students must be 18 years of age, have a high school degree or equivalency and a documented intellectual disability.



Empowers students to become independent in self-advocacy and life skills.
