Challenges: Think About

- ▶ Who are you serving/will serve?
 - Gender, ethnicity, SES, age?
- ▶ What are needs of business and industry?
 - Career opportunities, credentials?
- ▶ What are the strengths of your institution?
 - Academics, services, partnerships?

Challenges: Think About

- ▶ Does enrollment reflect ethnic diversity of your area?
The State?
- ▶ Do your approaches meet the needs of your multicultural community?
- ▶ Are the students prepared for their postsecondary education program?
- ▶ Are student completers achieving employment?
- ▶ What are key program predictors of success?

K - 12: Create the Demand

- ▶ Empower students and families
- ▶ Target postsecondary education programs in students' IEPs (SPP/APR I-13!)
- ▶ *Prepare* students to access and succeed in a FPCTP!
- ▶ Create and connect a CCT Club with your postsecondary ed institutions
- ▶ Create and provide choices for postsecondary education - reach out to postsecondary education institutions to offer a range of opportunities across Florida

PSE: Create the Supply

- ▶ Create and provide choices for postsecondary education - offer a range of opportunities across Florida
- ▶ Connect with other partners: VR, APD, FDDC
- ▶ Expand your team as needed
- ▶ Access the Center's resources

Lessons Learned

- ▶ Institutional capacity varies widely
 - Staff commitments
 - Resource allocation
 - # of students that can be supported in the program
 - Types of student supports provided
- ▶ We can provide you data about current FPCTPs

Lessons Learned

- ▶ Collaboration is essential - Wide range of partners and team members
- ▶ Students need a range of options and supports
- ▶ People need ideas and examples
- ▶ All institutions do most things differently
- ▶ Connection with K-12 systems is fundamental

The FCSUA Provides

- ▶ Assistance to prepare FPCTP applications and grant proposals, and to request scholarships
- ▶ Assistance to design evaluation plans, and to collect and analyze evaluation data
- ▶ Assistance to develop the Federal CTP proposal
- ▶ Feedback to the State legislators re: funding and policy needs
